The Quest Continues

Silver Quest's 2009 fall drill program is proving to have been very successful. [Assay results](#) from 2 more drill holes were released today. Both holes contained remarkable values of silver and good values of gold from surface and open at depth. Drill hole D-09-122 intersected 33.9 g/t (1 oz/t) silver over 96 metres, ending in mineralization. Drill hole D-09-111 intersected 16.8 g/t (0.5 oz/t) silver over 97 metres, again ending in mineralization. The best intersection was in D-09-111, 15 metres of 63.7 g/t (1.86 oz/t) silver and 0.81 g/t (0.02 oz/t) gold.

Significant assay intercepts include:

These two holes were drilled from the same collar location, in the central part of Zone 2. One was drilled the east the other was drilled to the west. The results indicate higher silver values towards the north end of Zone 2, when compared to the high gold values found in the southern portion of the zone in D-09-109 and D-09-110.

The Capoose Project continues to grow and get more interesting with every drill hole. With the addition of Yale Simpson as a new technical director to the board last week and a new VP Exploration, Silver Quest appears to be ramping up for large exploration program at Capoose in 2010.
